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Whereas, the county commissioners must begin the necessary preparation of the ballot to be presented to voters of Knox County; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. To authorize the borrowing of money. Resolved: That the Knox County commissioners are authorized to borrow and expend a sum not to exceed \$500,000 for construction or renovations of a communications and 9-1-1 center located in Knox County; and be it further

Sec. 2. Referendum for ratification. Resolved: That this resolve 18 must be submitted to the legal voters of Knox County. The dates of submission must be determined by the Knox County 20 commissioners, but may not be later than 18 months after adjournment of the Legislature. The Knox County commissioners 22 are authorized to expend the funds necessary to implement the referendum. 24

The county commissioners shall cause the preparation of the 26 required ballots on which the county commissioners shall state the subject matter of this resolve in the following question: 28

Do you favor authorizing the Knox County commissioners to 30 borrow an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for construction of the Knox County Communications Center?

The voters shall indicate by a cross or a check mark placed against the words Yes or No their opinion of the question.

36 This resolve takes effect immediately upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters voting at the election if the 38 total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this resolve equals or exceeds 30% of the total votes for all 40 candidates for Governor cast in the most recent gubernatorial election in the county. If at the first election the total number of votes for and against acceptance of this resolve is 42 less than 30% of the total votes for all candidates for Governor 44 cast in the most recent gubernatorial election, the county commissioners may submit the question to voters not more than one 46 other time within the time prescribed in this section; and be it further 48

Sec. 3. Emergency clause referenda; effective date. Resolved: That 50 in view of the emergency cited in the preamble,

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" to H.P. 40, L.D. 54 this resolve takes effect when approved only for the purpose of 2 permitting its submission to the legal voters of Knox County.' Further amend the resolve by inserting at the end before the 4 summary the following: 6 8 **'FISCAL NOTE** 10 This resolve requires the Knox County commissioners to hold a referendum concerning the construction of the Knox County 12 Communications Center. The costs of this referendum to Knox County can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the 14 Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement 16 to fund 90% of the additional local costs.' 18 SUMMARY 20 This amendment changes the title, reduces the bond issue 22 amount to be borrowed from \$600,000 to \$500,000 and authorizes the Knox County commissioners to hold a countywide referendum on 24 the bond issue to build the Knox County Communications Center.
