2 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the
Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6 **Whereas,** Knox County has limited space to provide for a
necessary communications and 9-1-1 system; and

8 **Whereas,** the need exists for an expanded communications
system in Knox County; and

10 **Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
12 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety; now, therefore, be it

16 **Sec. 1. To authorize the borrowing of money. Resolved:** That the
18 Knox County commissioners are authorized to borrow and expend a
sum not to exceed \$600,000 for construction or renovations of a
20 communications and 9-1-1 center located in Knox County.

22 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.
