Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after 2 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

- Whereas, Knox County has limited space to provide for a necessary communications and 9-1-1 system; and 6
- Whereas, the need exists for an expanded communications 8 system in Knox County; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 12 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 14 safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. To authorize the borrowing of money. Resolved: That the Knox County commissioners are authorized to borrow and expend a 18 sum not to exceed \$600,000 for construction or renovations of a 20 communications and 9-1-1 center located in Knox County.

22 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

SUMMARY

28 This resolve authorizes the Knox County commissioners to borrow a sum of money up to \$600,000 for construction or 30 renovations of a communications center in Knox County.
