

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §4011, sub-§4 is enacted to read:

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4. Probation. Notwithstanding Title 17-A, section 1202, a person convicted of a violation of this section must be placed on probation for a period of 2 years.

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SUMMARY

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This bill increases the period of probation for domestic abuse from one year to 2 years.
