	1. Records to be retained. A hospital licensed by the
8	State under this Title or a health care practitioner, as provided in section 1711-B, shall retain records regarding the health care
10	services provided by the hospital or practitioner as follows:
12	A. Records of a person 18 years of age or older must be retained for 3 years; and
