COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 65, L.D. 78, Bill, "An Act to Ensure Funding for a Replacement Correctional Facility in Washington County"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Establishing the Replacement Simultaneously of State Correctional Facilities in Cumberland and Washington Counties as the First Priority If Additional General Obligation Bond Issues or Lease Appropriation Bonds are Authorized by the Legislature'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Replacement of state correctional facilities in Cumberland and Washington counties. Resolved: That the first priority of the State, in authorizing new state correctional facilities to be financed in part or in whole with general obligation bonds or lease appropriation bonds issued by the Maine Governmental Facilities Authority, is the replacement simultaneously of state correctional facilities in Cumberland County and Washington County.'

SUMMARY

This amendment retitles and replaces the bill with a resolve that sets the replacement simultaneously of new state
