	§2115. Use of hand-held telephone while operating motor vehicle

	It is unlawful for a person operating a motor vehicle to use
8	a telephone that requires the operator to hold the telephone in the operator's hand.

	Violation of this section is a traffic infraction subject to
12	the a forfeiture of not less than \$100 for the first violation,
	\$200 for the 2nd and \$250 for the 3rd and each subsquent
14	violation committed within one year.

	This bill prohibits a person from using a hand-held
20	telephone while operating a motor vehicle if the operator holds the telephone in the operator's hand while driving. The bill
22	makes the offense a traffic infraction.
