32	time but may be significant. Unless General Fund appropriations are provided to fund at least 90% of the additional costs or a
34	Mandate Preamble is amended to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt this mandate from the
36	funding requirement, the municipalities may not be required to implement these changes.'
