HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 76, L.D. 89, "Resolve, to Study Standardized Periods of Military Service for Award of State of Maine Veterans' Benefits"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the 2nd line (page 2, line 23 in amendment) by striking out the following: "13" and inserting in its place the following: '18'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by inserting before subsection 1 the following:

'1. One member from each of the following 5 veterans organizations:

- A. The American Legion;
- B. Veterans of Foreign Wars;
- C. Disabled American Veterans;
- D. AMVETS; and
- E. Military Order of the Purple Heart;'

Further amend the amendment in section 2 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 10 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 10. Appropriation. Resolved: That the following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve.
