Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §344-B, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 804,
4 Pt. B, §4 and affected by §7, is amended to read:

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4. Multiple permits. For projects that require more than
one permit from the department, the commissioner and the
8 applicant shall determine the timetable or timetables applicable
to all permit or license applications required for that project
10 at a presubmission meeting. At the presubmission meeting, the
12 commissioner shall provide the applicant with a list of the
information necessary for all permit applications required for
the project to be accepted as complete for processing.

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SUMMARY

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This bill requires that when a presubmission meeting is held
for a project that requires multiple permits from the Department
20 of Environmental Protection, the Commissioner of Environmental
Protection shall provide the applicant with a list of the
22 information necessary for all the required permit applications to
be accepted as complete for processing.

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
