24 Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph D in subparagraph
26 (8) in the 3rd line (page 2, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the
following: "within the built-up portion"

28 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
summary the following:

FISCAL NOTE

32 The Department of Transportation will incur some minor
34 additional costs to post certain signs on designated ATV-access
36 routes. These costs can be absorbed within the department's
existing budgeted resources.'

SUMMARY

40 This amendment allows the operation of ATV's on the extreme
42 right of a public way in any part of a municipality, if the way
has been designated as an ATV-access route. It also adds a
fiscal note to the bill.
