The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development or the commissioner's designee must be a member of 10 the task force; and be it further

12 Sec. 3. **Appointments:** meetings. **Resolved:** That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the 14 effective date of this resolve. The appointing authorities shall notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council once the 16 selections have been made. Within 15 days after appointment of all members, the chairs shall call and convene the first meeting 18 of the task force; and be it further' '

Resolved: That the legislative members of the task force receive legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 2, for each day's attendance at task force hearings, and other members of the task force not otherwise reimbursed by their employer or other entity are entitled to receive reimbursement for reasonable expenses for each day's attendance at task force hearings; and be it further

SUMMARY

This amendment corrects the appointment of the chairs of the 16 Task Force to Study the Effect of Government Regulation on Small Businesses. It limits resulting legislation to a bill and 18 corrects the appropriation.
