	Current law requires that school administrative units that
24	place students in out-of-district placements receive adjustments that offset the costs of those placements. However, the funds
26	for those adjustments are limited to the amount appropriated by the Legislature. Appropriations for the past several years have
28	addressed less than 25% of the amount needed to fully fund this adjustment. This bill appropriates the funds needed to fully
30	fund the out-of-district adjustment costs.
