	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§16, ¶E, as amended by PL 1997, c.
4	243, §2, is further amended to read:
б	E. Except-as-provided in subsection -20, -paragraph-G, -erects Erects or uses either a pertable-er permanent tree ladder or
8	stand attached to a tree on the land of another person, unless:
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12	(1) That person has obtained verbal or written authorization to erect and use a tree ladder or stand from the landowner or the landowner's representative;

16	(2) The tree ladder or stand is plainly labeled with a 2-inch by 4-inch tag identifying the name and address
18	of the person or persons authorized by the landowner to use the tree stand or ladder.
20	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §7406, sub-§20, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1995, c.
22	667, Pt. A, §31, is repealed.
24	SUMMARY
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28	This bill allows the use of a portable tree ladder or stand on the land of another landowner without obtaining the landowner's permission.
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
