2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7156** is enacted to read:

6 **§7156. Voluntary contribution to "Hooked on Fishing Not on  
8 Drugs" program**

10 The commissioner shall develop a fishing permit form that  
12 allows fishing license applicants to voluntarily contribute an  
14 additional \$1 to be applied toward the "Hooked on Fishing Not on  
16 Drugs" program established in section 7035, subsection 18. All  
18 fees collected under this section accrue to the "Hooked on  
20 Fishing Not on Drugs" program.

16 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill establishes a system whereby fishing license  
20 applicants may voluntarily contribute \$1 to be applied to the  
"Hooked on Fishing Not on Drugs" program.
