Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §1023, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1989, c. 185, is further amended to read:

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a fee not to exceed \$25 \$40 for the charges pursuant to which the defendant is presently in custody. The bail commissioner shall submit such forms as the Judicial Department shall-direct directs to verify the amount of fees received under this subsection. sheriff of the county in which the defendant is detained may create a fund for the distribution by the sheriff or the

5. Fees. A bail commissioner shall is entitled to receive

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sheriff's designee for the payment in whole or in part of the \$25 \$40 bail commissioner fee for those defendants who do not have the financial ability to pay that fee.

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SUMMARY

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This bill increases the fee a bail commissioner may charge from \$25 to \$40.
