2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §405, sub-§6, ¶F**, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 758,
is amended to read:

6 F. Discussions of information contained in records made,
8 maintained or received by a body or agency when access by
the general public to those records is prohibited by
statute; and

10 **Sec. 2. 1 MRSA §405, sub-§6, ¶G** is enacted to read:

12 G. Discussion of examination content, structure, approval,
14 scoring and weighting process; consultation between a body
16 or agency and any entity that provides examination services
18 to that body or entity; review of examinations with
applicants.

20 **SUMMARY**

22 This bill authorizes a body or agency of State Government to
24 deliberate in executive session concerning various aspects of the
examination process. This authority is necessary to ensure the
integrity of state examination.
