## An Act to Allow Persons with Disabilities to Obtain More than One Disability Registration Plate.

A, §4, is amended to read: 4 Disability registration plates. Disability registration б 2. plates must bear the International Symbol of Access, which must be in a color that contrasts with the background and is must be 8 the same size as the letters or numbers on the plate. The Secretary of State may issue a -- set sets of disability 10 registration plates to the following: 12 Α. A person with a disability; 14 A vehicle owner who is a spouse, parent or legal Β. 16 quardian of a person with a disability when the person with a disability is a resident of this State, a member of the 18 relative's or guardian's household and dependent on the vehicle owner as the primary means of transportation; or 20 An organization or agency in this State that transports C. 22 persons with disabilities. Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §521, sub-§5, as repealed and replaced by PL 24 1995, c. 482, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read: 26 5. Application; issuance. An application for a disability plate plates or placard placards must be accompanied by the 28 certificate of a physician attesting to that person's physical 30 disability as defined in subsection 1. The Secretary of State shall issue to an eligible applicant one set of disability plates 32 and one windshield placard or one windshield placard and a 2nd placard upon request. The Secretary of State may issue more than 34 one set of disability plates on request. Proof of a disability must be submitted every 4 years on a form prescribed by the 36 Secretary of State, except, when the Secretary of State determines the disability to be permanent, the time may be 38 extended. When the applicant's need for the disability placard terminates or the applicant dies, the plate plates or plaeard placards must be immediately returned to the Secretary of State. 40 42 **SUMMARY** 44 This bill allows persons with disabilities to obtain more than one set of disability registration plates. 46
