SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 69, L.D. 172, Bill, "An Act to Enhance Maine's Relationship with Aomori, Japan by Hosting a Cultural Exchange"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 24 to 29 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Nonlapsing funds. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, an amount not to exceed \$110,000 of General Fund appropriations in the Personal Services line category on June 30, 1999 in the Governor's office program in the Executive Department may not lapse but must be carried forward to June 30, 2000.'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of the 3rd indented paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 31 to 33 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 (page 1, lines 16 to 31 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.
