- Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6505-A, sub-§5, as amended by PL 1997, c.
 4 297, §2, is further amended to read:
- 5. Gear. A person issued a license under this section may utilize ene-elver-fyke-net, one Sheldon eel trap or one dip net to fish for or take elvers without paying the fee required for a first net-er trap pursuant to section 6505-B. A license issued under this section must identify the number and types of nets or traps that the license holder may use pursuant to this section and section 6505-B.
- Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6505-B, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1997, c. 297, §§3 and 4, is further amended to read:
- 1. Elver fyke net prohibition and Sheldon eel trap fee. It is unlawful for a person to submerge an elver fyke net in the coastal waters of the State to fish for or take elvers. It is unlawful for a person to submerge an-elver-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel trap in the coastal waters of the State to fish for or take elvers unless the net-er trap owner pays annually the following fees:
- A. Fifty dollars per net-er trap for the use of a first or
 26 2nd elver-fyke-net-er Sheldon eel trap, except that the fee
 under this paragraph does not apply to an-elver-fyke-er a
 28 Sheldon eel trap a person utilizes pursuant to section
 6505-A, subsection 5. For the purposes of assessing fees
 30 under this subsection, an-elver-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel
 trap utilized pursuant to section 6505-A, subsection 5 is
 32 the first net-er trap;
- B. One hundred dollars per net-er trap for the use of a 3rd elver-fyke-net-er Sheldon eel trap; and
- C. Two hundred dollars per net-er trap for the use of a 4th and 5th elver-fyke-net-er Sheldon eel trap.
 - Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §6505-B, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1997, c. 575, §2, is further amended to read:
 - 2. Tags for Sheldon eel trap. It is unlawful for a person to submerge an-elver-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel trap in the coastal waters of the State to fish for or take elvers unless a tag issued by the department is affixed to the shoreside wing of the net-er trap and is clearly visible. The department may issue a replacement tag when an owner issued a tag documents that a net er trap has been damaged or lost.
- Sec. 4. 12 MRSA §6575, as amended by PL 1997, c. 91, §4, is further amended to read:

2 §6575. Closed season; elver harvesting

- 1. Closed season. It is unlawful for a person to fish for or take elvers within the coastal waters of the State from June 16th to noon on March 15th of the following year.
- 8 2. Setting traps. It is unlawful for a person to immerse or leave immersed a-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel trap in any river, stream or brook of the coastal waters of the State from February 15th to noon of March 15th.

3. Locating traps. It is unlawful between February 15th and noon of March 15th for a person to designate or claim by any means a location in which an-elver-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel trap would be placed or set.

- 4. Nets of certain sizes. It is unlawful for a person to immerse or leave immersed in the coastal waters of the State a
 20 fyke-net, Sheldon eel trap or dip net fitted with netting that measures 1/8 inch bar mesh or less from midnight of June 15th to
 22 noon of March 15th of the following year.
- Sec. 5. 12 MRSA §6575-A, as amended by PL 1997, c. 575, §3, is further amended to read:

§6575-A. Closed period; elver harvesting

It is unlawful for a person to fish for or take elvers from noon Friday to noon Sunday. A person may leave an-elver-fyke-net er a Sheldon eel trap in the coastal waters of the State during the closed period if the net-er trap is left in a condition that

prevents the capture of elvers.

Sec. 6. 12 MRSA §6575-B, as amended by PL 1997, c. 575, §4, is further amended to read:

§6575-B. Method of elver fishing; limits on gear

- 1. Gear. It is unlawful for a person to fish for or take elvers by any method other than by dip net,-elver-fyke-net or Sheldon eel trap.
- 2. Number of Sheldon eel traps. It is unlawful from noon of March 15th to midnight of June 15th for a person to immerse at any one time:
- 48 A---Mere-than-5-elver-fyke-nets;
- B. More than 5 Sheldon eel traps; -er.

C. -- Any-combination-of-elver-fyke-nets-and-Sheldon-eel-traps that-total-more-than-5-nets-and-traps-Rebuttable presumption. It is a rebuttable presumption that an-elver-fyke-net, a Sheldon eel trap or elver dip net immersed in any coastal waters of the State from noon of March 15th to midnight of June 15th is immersed for the purpose of fishing for or taking elvers. Я Prohibition on fishing from boats. It is unlawful for a 10 person to set or tend an-elver-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel trap 12 from a boat or to fish for or take elvers from a boat. A person may transport an-elver-fyke-net, a Sheldon eel trap or a dip net 14 by boat. 16 Use of dip nets. It is unlawful for a person to use a dip net to fish for or take elvers while standing in the coastal waters of the State. 18 Sec. 7. 12 MRSA §6575-C, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 20 536, Pt. A, §9, is repealed. 22 Sec. 8. 12 MRSA §6575-D, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 24 536, Pt. A, §9, is amended to read: 26 1. Prohibition. It is unlawful for any person other than a marine patrol officer or the license holder issued a tag for an 28 elver-fyke-net-er a Sheldon eel trap to utilize, transfer, alter, possess or in any manner handle the net--er trap unless that person has been issued an elver fishing license under section 30 6505-A and: 32 Is in the presence of the license holder issued a tag for the net-er trap and has the license holder's permission 34 to tend the net-er trap; or 36 Is issued written permission by a marine patrol officer 38 to tend the net-er trap of a license holder issued a tag. A marine patrol officer may issue a person written permission 40 for the person to tend the license holder's net or trap if the license holder can not tend the net-er trap because of a 42 disability or personal or family medical condition. 44
