4 This amendment removes the language in the committee amendment that prohibits state agencies, departments, boards, 6 commissions, institutions, authorities and public instrumentalities from charging a processing fee or reducing the 8 reimbursement rate for electronic filing. This amendment also removes the appropriation and allocation sections in the 10 committee amendment.
