## **'FISCAL NOTE**

4 The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife will incur some minor additional costs to process the transfer of antlerless deer permits from an adult family member to a junior hunter or a person 65 years of age or older. These costs can be absorbed within the department's existing budgeted resources.'
