2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §1874, 2nd ¶** is enacted to read:

6 In any legislation that appropriates or allocates funds
8 designated for the waterway, the waterway must appear as a
10 separate program to which funds are appropriated or allocated
12 within the bureau.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill ensures that the Allagash Wilderness Waterway will appear in any appropriation or allocation section as a separate program within the Department of Conservation, Bureau of Parks and Lands.
