COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 134, L.D. 196, Bill, "An Act to Prohibit Rewards to Fish and Wildlife Informants"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "\$7065." in the first paragraph in the first line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "amount" the following: 'by any state agency'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the minority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The amendment clarifies that only state agencies may not give awards to persons who report violations of fish and wildlife laws.
