

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7065 is enacted to read:**

6 **§7065. Rewards to informants**

8 The payment of a reward of any monetary amount to any person
10 who reports a violation of any provision of this Title is
12 prohibited.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill prohibits state agencies or private persons from giving monetary rewards to persons who report violations of the fish and wildlife laws.
