4 The amendment replaces and retitles the bill. The amendment repeals the requirement that a candidate for sheriff qualify for an executive certificate under the Maine Criminal Justice Academy б standards and instead requires a candidate to meet only the Maine Criminal Justice Academy basic law enforcement training standards 8 or meet the basic corrections training standards and have 5 years

10 of supervisory employment experience.
