2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6446, sub-§3-A is enacted to read:**

6 **3-A. Person not limited to fishing in one zone. This**
8 **section may not be construed to limit a person who fishes for**
lobsters to fishing in only one zone.

10 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill clarifies that a person who fishes for lobsters
14 may not be limited to fishing in only one zone by laws that
authorize the establishment of lobster management zones.
