An Act to Create the Maine Tax filer's Prescription Medication Plan.

_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §258 is enacted to read:
4	§258. Public prescription drug plan
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	The department shall establish the Maine Tax Filer's
8	Prescription Medication Plan, referred to in this section as "the
	plan," to acquire prescription medications at the best available
10	market prices and to make those medications available to gualified residents of the State.
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	1. Purchase of prescription medications. The department
14	may form and maintain or join wholesale purchasing consortiums
	with other states for the purpose of acquiring federally approved
16	prescription medications directly from manufacturers at the best
	available prices.
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	2. Delivery of prescription medications. The department
20	may accept delivery of prescription medications acquired under
	this section or may arrange for delivery to pharmacies and
22	hospitals licensed in this State.
24	3. Distribution of prescription medications. Licensed
	pharmacies and hospitals within the State may distribute
26	prescription medications acquired under this section to qualified
	residents of the State and may charge them a price for each unit
28	that is no greater than the wholesale unit price paid by the
	department plus 10%. At the end of each month, the pharmacy or
30	hospital shall send to the department a payment for medications
	distributed under this section equal to the total of the unit
32	wholesale prices paid by the State.
34	4. Qualified residents. Enrollment in the plan requires
	payment of a \$10 enrollment fee for each person enrolled and
36	filing of a personal income tax return for that person, either as
	the tax filer or as a listed dependent. The enrolled person may
38	participate in the plan for the 12 months following the date of
	payment of the enrollment fee.
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	5. Rulemaking. The department shall adopt rules to
42	implement the plan. Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection
	are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375,
44	subchapter II-A.
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- •	SUMMARY
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	This bill establishes the Maine Tax Filer's Prescription
50	Medication Plan to provide medications to Maine residents at the

lowest available prices through direct purchasing by the 2 Department of Human Services.
