	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the
8	context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the
	following meanings.

	A. "Caller-ID blocking" means a service or device that
12	blocks receipt by a telephone subscriber of the caller's
14	telephone access line identification number or other
14	telephone access line identification information.
16	2. Prohibition. A person in this State may not initiate a
	solicitation call to a telephone subscriber in this State if the
18	call is subject to caller-ID blocking.
20	3. Penalty. Violation of subsection 2 is an unfair trade
	practice as prohibited by Title 5, section 207.
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24	SUMMARY
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26	This bill prohibits entities conducting intrastate telephone
	solicitation from using caller-ID blocking.
