- 2 Further amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "<u>\$2112-A.</u>" in subsection 3 by inserting after 4 paragraph C the following:
- b. The operator or the operator's employer holds a valid off-premise catering license issued under Title 28-A.
 8 section 1052 and the alcohol is being transported either to or from a catered event.'
- Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any 12 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

18 This amendment adds an exemption for licensed off-site catering services to the provisions of the committee amendment 20 dealing with transportation of opened containers of alcohol and amends the law pertaining to private transportation of partially 22 consumed bottles of table wine to require that they be transported in compliance with the open container law proposed in 24 the bill.
