SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 163, L.D. 225, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Maine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992 as it Relates to Compensation for Amputation of a Body Part"


Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "January 1, 1993" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 2, 2000'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 16 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "January 1, 1993" and inserting in its place the following: 'January 2, 2000'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill by removing the provision for retroactivity. It provides that benefits apply to injuries that occur on or after January 2, 2000, which is the start of the first full workweek.
