COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 98, L.D. 237, Bill, "An Act to Enhance Senior Volunteerism in Maine"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

**Sec. 1. Appropriation.** The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

All Other	\$44,000	\$44,000

Provides additional funds for 8 community-based senior volunteer programs. This amount, along with amounts included in the current services budget, will provide each program with \$15,000 annually.'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 98, L.D. 237

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the  
summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

	<b>1999-00</b>	<b>2000-01</b>
<b>APPROPRIATIONS/ALLOCATIONS</b>		
General Fund	\$44,000	\$44,000

This bill includes General Fund appropriations of \$44,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 to increase the amounts provided to the 8 community-based senior volunteer programs so that each program receives \$15,000 annually.

The Governor's proposed "current services" budget includes \$76,000 in each of fiscal years 1999-00 and 2000-01 for these programs.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill. It deletes the law provisions regarding community-based agencies, adds an appropriation of \$44,000 annually and adds a fiscal note to the bill.
