Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §574-A, as amended by PL 1989, c. 508, §9, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

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This subchapter does not apply to any parcel of forest land that is owned by a public municipal corporation and located outside its corporate limits and confines.

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SUMMARY

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This bill removes from participation in the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law any forest land that is owned by a public municipal corporation that is located outside the limits of that public municipal corporation.

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
