COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 171, L.D. 249, Bill, "An Act to Give Citizens 70 Years of Age and Older Free Bear and Duck Hunters Stamps"

Amend the bill by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

**FISCAL NOTE**

This bill requires that residents over 70 years of age must be issued a free bear hunting permit and migratory bird permit. Issuing free bear hunting permits to residents over 70 years of age will reduce annual General Fund revenue by \$1,000 beginning in fiscal year 1999-00.

Issuing free migratory waterfowl permits to residents over 70 years of age will reduce permit fee collections. The estimated annual reduction of dedicated revenue is \$1,350 beginning in fiscal year 1999-00.'
