Sec. 1. The Executive Director of the Legislative Council directed to 2 develop a system to cable televise the proceedings of the Legislature. Resolved: That the Executive Director of the Legislative Council 4 is directed to develop a system to cable televise the proceedings of the Legislature, to go into effect no later than January 1, 2001; and be it further 6 Sec. 2. Report date. Resolved: That the Executive Director of 8 the Legislative Council shall report on the implementation of this resolve, including any recommended legislation, to the joint 10 standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters by January 1, 2000. 12
