6	7. Access to care. Access to and use of health care services by all or a particular group of the people of this
8	State, including, but not limited to, the use of ambulatory health care services. The access and use may be categorized by
10	specialty and type of practice of the health professional or health facility providing the service; and
12	8. Public health. Public health policies and programs.
