2	Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §905-A is enacted to read:
4	§905-A. Misuse of legal identification
б	1. A person is guilty of misuse of legal identification if
8	that person intentionally or knowingly presents or uses a form of legal identification that is stolen or forged.
10	2. Misuse of legal identification is a Class C crime.

16	This bill creates the crime of misuse of legal identification. The crime is committed if a person intentionally
18	or knowingly presents or uses a form of legal identification that is stolen or forged. The penalty classification for the crime is
20	Class C.
