8	This bill seeks to build on the work undertaken by the task force created by Resolve 1997, chapter 103 by doing at least the

12	<ol> <li>Increase the collection of fines, forfeitures and costs imposed by courts for civil and criminal violations;</li> </ol>

	2. Expand the jurisdiction of the District Court Violations
16	Bureau to include all civil violations;
18	3. Prohibit issuance and renewal of any license or other
