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	1. Domestic violence prevention plate. The Secretary of
20	State, upon receiving an application and evidence of payment of
	the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482, the
22	registration fee required by section 501 and the administrative
	fee and voluntary contribution provided for in subsection 2,
24	shall issue a registration certificate and a set of domestic
	violence prevention registration plates to be used in lieu of
26	regular registration plates. These plates must bear
	identification numbers and letters.
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	2. Administrative fee and contribution to the Domestic
30	Violence Prevention Fund. Domestic violence prevention special
	registration plates are not required for registration of a motor
32	vehicle. A person may contribute to the Domestic Violence
	Prevention Fund by applying for the special registration plates
34	and submitting, in addition to the regular motor vehicle
	registration fee, a sum of \$20 credited as follows:
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	A. Fourteen dollars to the Domestic Violence Prevention

44	3. Design. The Secretary of State shall determine a design
	for the domestic violence prevention plates. If the design

	Domestic violence prevention plates are issued in accordance with
50	the provisions of this section and section 453.

	4. Renewal fee. In addition to the regular motor vehicle
2	registration fee prescribed by law, the annual renewal
	contribution for domestic violence prevention registration plates
4	is \$15, which must be deposited with the Treasurer of State and
	<u>credited as follows:</u>
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	A. Fourteen dollars to the Domestic Violence Prevention
8	Fund established in Title 22, section 5327-A; and
10	B. One dollar to the Highway Fund to reimburse the
	Secretary of State for costs associated with the production
12	and issuance of the plates.
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	SUMMARY
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This act establishes the Domestic Violence Prevention Fund and the domestic violence prevention registration plate, under which \$14 of the registration fee is dedicated to domestic violence prevention programs.
