'Sec. 4. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall study current policies governing the use of high-speed chases and emergency responses, current practices involved in high-speed chases and emergency responses, a history of the high-speed chases and emergency responses resulting in personal injuries or property damage that have occurred in this State and a review of other states' policies and procedures regarding the use of high-speed chases and emergency responses. The commission may seek information from experts and other interested parties. Using this information, the commission shall consider the need for reducing the use of high-speed chases, setting additional parameters regarding when and how high-speed chases are to be conducted, requiring mandatory driver training for emergency response vehicles and establishing a model policy for emergency responses. The commission shall make a report in accordance with

section 8; and be it further

Sec. 5. Staff assistance. Resolved: That, upon approval from the Legislative Council, the Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide necessary staffing resources to the commission; and be it further'
