The amendment requires the Commissioner of Transportation to report to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over transportation matters in February 2001 and February 2003 on the progress of interagency efforts to improve public and recreational access to water bodies and snowmobile access across bridges. The scope of those interagency efforts are detailed in a memorandum of agreement recently signed by the Department of Transportation, the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife, the Department of Conservation and the Department of Marine Resources. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
