- Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2524, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
- 1. Persons qualified to draw blood for blood tests. Only a physician, registered physician's assistant, registered nurse, registered lab technician, certified phlebotomist or a person certified by the Department of Human Services may draw a specimen of blood for the purpose of determining the blood-alcohol level or drug concentration.

This bill adds registered lab technicians and certified phlebotomists to the list of persons who may draw blood samples to determine a person's blood-alcohol level or drug concentration.
