Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

3 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§38**, as amended by PL 1993, c. 612,
4 §1, is further amended to read:

7 **38. Bates College.** The signs must be provided by Bates
8 College. The Maine Turnpike shall erect one sign on the side of
9 the northbound lanes between exits 12 and 13 and one sign on the
10 side of the southbound lanes north of exit 13. The Maine
11 Turnpike Authority is responsible for the maintenance of the
12 signs; and

13 **Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§39**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 612,
14 §2, is amended to read:

17 **39. Saco Plaza; facilities at former Exit 5.** Signs for the
18 facilities permitted by Title 23, section 1967, subsection 5 must
19 be installed and maintained along the northbound and southbound
20 lanes of the Maine Turnpike at appropriate locations leading to
21 and at the former exit 5 of the Maine Turnpike. The signs must
22 be provided and maintained by the Maine Turnpike Authority. The
23 signs must be paid for by the Department of Administrative and
24 Financial Services and the owners or operators of any facilities
25 described in the signs. The Department of Administrative and
26 Financial Services and owners or operators of the facilities may
27 decide upon the division of expenses.

28

29 One sign along the northbound lanes and one sign along the
30 southbound lanes must incorporate the single or multicolored
31 logos or designs used by the hotel or convention center
32 operator. These signs must briefly describe the services
33 available to the traveling public; and

35 **Sec. 3. 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§40** is enacted to read:

37 **40. Lakeland Trail.** The Lakeland Trail, Lakeland Trail
38 signs must be constructed and maintained on Interstate 95, with
39 one sign no more than one mile southerly from exit 54 and one
40 sign no more than one mile northerly from exit 55.
