HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 214, L.D. 292, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Payment Options for Certain Employers"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "§621-A." by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Exception. Notwithstanding subsections 1 and 2, an employer who paid wages more frequently than semimonthly as of January 1, 1999 shall continue to pay wages at least as frequently as the wages were paid prior to January 1, 1999.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires employers to continue to pay wages more frequently than semimonthly if the employer was making more frequent payments as of January 1, 1999.
