SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 214, L.D. 292, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Payment Options for Certain Employers"


Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "~~§621-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 34 and 35 in amendment) by striking out the following: 'not to exceed semimonthly.' and inserting in its place the following: '. For an employee whose hourly wage exceeds 200% of the state minimum wage, the intervals may not exceed 16 days. For all other employees, the interval may not exceed 7 days.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides for 2 payment intervals for employees' wages. An employee whose hourly wage exceeds 200% of the state minimum wage may be paid at an interval not to exceed 16 days. All other employees would be paid at an interval not to exceed 7 days.
