SENATE AMENDMENT " D " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 214, L.D. 292, Bill, "An Act to Enhance the Payment Options for Certain Employers"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in that part designated "§621-A." in subsection 1 by striking out all of the first sentence (page 1, lines 33 to 35 in amendment) and inserting in its place the following: 'At regular intervals not to exceed 14 days, every employer must pay all wages earned by each employee.'

SUMMARY

The amendment clarifies that payment of wages must occur at intervals not to exceed 14 days.
