HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 117, L.D. 314, Bill, "An Act to Restrict Circulators of Initiated Petitions from Being within 250 Feet of Voting Places"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

'An Act to Restrict the Circulation of Petitions within Certain Areas of Voting Places'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 2nd indented paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 6 and 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "within 250 feet of the entrance to the voting place or within the voting place" and inserting in its place the following: 'in the room where ballots are cast at an election and in the areas of entrance to and egress from that room'

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits the circulation of petitions in the actual room in which voting takes place, instead of the entire building, and in the entrance and exit areas of that room.
