This-limitation 38 dees-net-prohibit-a-candidate-from-attending-the-voting-place-and orally-communicating-with-voters, -as-long-as-the-candidate-does A 40 candidate may not be within 250 feet of the voting place except to vote and may not attempt to influence their the vote of other 42 voters.
