2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2251, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1993, c.
4	683, Pt. A, §2 and affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:
б	1. Definition. As used in this section, "reportable accident" means an accident on a public way or a place where
8	public traffic may reasonably be anticipated, resulting in bodily injury or death to a person or apparent property damage of \$500
10	<u>\$1,000</u> or more.
