Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1997, c.
4 432, §45, is further amended to read:

3. Date and length of season. On or after January 1, 1982,
the commissioner may establish open seasons on moose within the
8 moose hunting zones established by the commissioner under
subsection 1-A, as long as the season is held during the 3rd week
10 of October and the number of hunting days in each year does not
exceed 6.
